CODE OF CONDUCT

All Club Coaches, Officials and Volunteers of Trinity Oxford Netball Club must:

- Respect the rules, regulations and requirements of the sport as defined by England Netball.
- Promote the positive aspects of the sport i.e. fair play and not condone rule violations.
- Promote netball for all, being respectful of gender, marital status, race, disability, sexuality, age or religion.
- Consider the well-being and safety of participants before the development of performance.
- Encourage performers to value their performances and not just results.
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with performers based on mutual trust and respect.
- Hold the appropriate, valid qualifications and insurance cover.
- Display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance.
- Never consume alcohol immediately before or during training or events.
- Avoid spending excessive amounts of time alone with young people away from others.
- Obtain prior agreement from the parent/guardian before transporting young people (apart from our own relations) to training or competitions, avoiding travelling alone.
- Ensure confidential information is not divulged unless with the express approval of the individual concerned.
- Be a positive role model.
